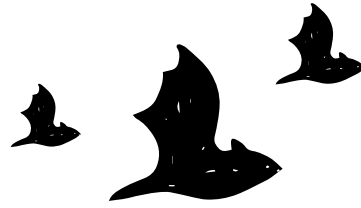


# Bat Habitat Certification

## Checklist



Before you apply to certify your bat habitat, make sure you have all of these requirements met!

### SIZE OF THE BAT HABITAT:

Square feet is a good unit of measure to use.

### PLEASE DESCRIBE THE TYPE OF ROOST:

1. AREA TYPE:

- Urban
- Suburban
- Farmland
- Wooded
- Desert

2. ROOST SITES (SELECT AT LEAST TWO FROM ALL ROOST SITES):

- Shagbark Hickory
- Oak
- Maple
- American Elm
- Cottonwood
- White Pine

3. OTHER ROOST SITES:

- Three Small Trees of Above Species (Any Combination)
- Dead or Dying Tree Over 9 Inches in Diameter.
- Cave/Abandon Mine
- Large Saguaro Cactus
- Large Palm Tree
- Bat House

4. FEEDING SITES (SELECT AT LEAST ONE FROM THE CHOICES BELOW):

- Native Wildflower Garden
- Night Garden
- Natural Meadow
- Native Cacti Garden (Southwest)
- Large Pond
- Organic Farm or Orchard

5. WATER SOURCE (SELECT AT LEAST ONE FROM THE CHOICES BELOW):

- Pond
- Birdbath
- Pool
